## £1,001,841.60 Secured For Kinship Carers and their Children

Over the last 4 years our Caring for Kin Project in Mid Ulster and Kinship Care Support Service in L'Derry have secured £1,001,841.60 in Fostercare Allowances, Residence Order Allowances, Guardian's Allowance and social security benefits for 146 kinship carers caring for 240 children. Thank you to the Big Lottery Fund for funding our services and believing in us and to our staff for making kinship carers and their youngsters count in Northern Ireland.


